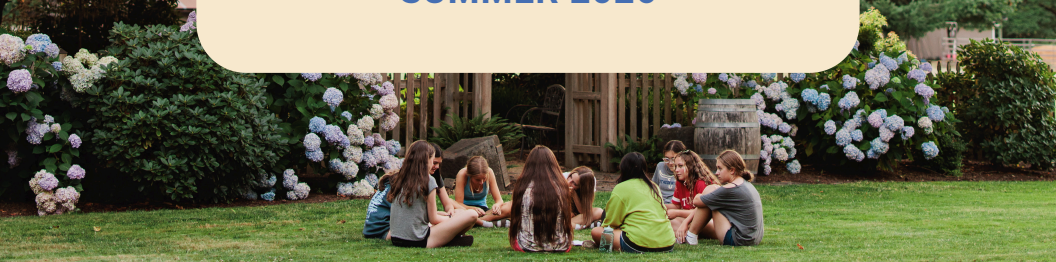

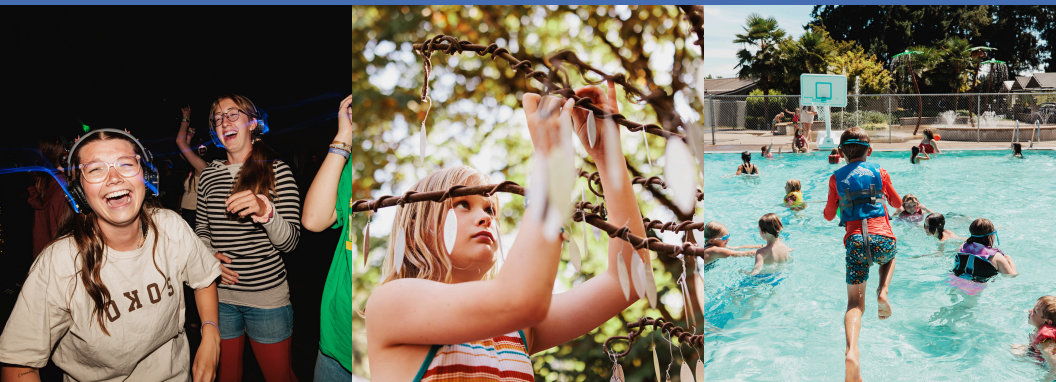

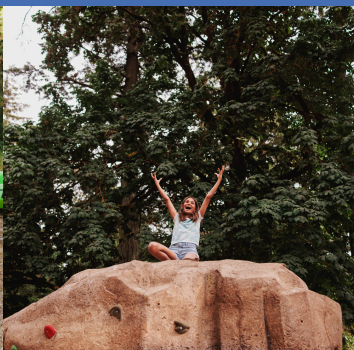
## **MAY 30<sup>TH</sup> ~ ESTHER CHAMPLIN, FOOD SERVICE COORDINATOR**
