Purpose

Location and Schedule

Location: 3550 Fox Meadows Road Eugene, OR 97408

Days/Times: Monday- Saturday 9am-8pm (Summer Hours)

Open Play Format: Reserve a Court through our webpage

- You can reserve courts at least 48 hours in advance and up to 30 days in advance.
- When you reserve a court, you will receive an email 1 hour prior to your reservation time with an entry code for your net.
- We ask that you reserve a slot for no more than 2 hours a day to leave space for others to play. If you want more than 2 hours or have a big group play, call 541-349-5813 or email abbyj@fbceugene.com

Who Can Participate

Open to all skill levels and ages.

Equipment

FBC supplies only nets for the games. Players should bring their own paddles and balls.

Players are responsible for setting up and taking down portable nets.

Players are encouraged to wear athletic attire that allows for easy movement and sneakers or non-marking shoes.

Do not use broken equipment or play on unsafe courts. If you notice broken or stolen equipment, please report it immediately using the QR code in the shed.

Court Guidelines

Players must demonstrate positive sportsmanship and encourage one another. No aggressive or disrespectful behavior.

For safety, do not chase your ball onto an adjacent court while they are playing. Call "ball" if your ball rolls onto another court and let them retrieve it for you.

Respect church property and equipment. Dispose of trash properly.

Play at your own risk. Surfaces may be slippery when wet.
