

AO & Trinity Application Process

Tour the House: You are always welcome and encouraged to visit the House. We want to do all we can to help you make an informed and wise decision about your interest living here. To arrange a visit, simply contact us via Instagram, email info@ccfeugene.com, or just knock on the door! Family and friends are always welcome too.

Get to Know the House: AO and Trinity are both a part of Collegiate Christian Fellowship (CCF), the college ministry of First Baptist Church of Eugene (FBC). We welcome you to come check out this ministry, which expands beyond house residents. CCF includes Bible studies, retreats, events and a weekly worship night on Thursdays.

Apply to the House: Apply any time online at fbceugene.com/college. Most interviews don't happen until spring when we know how many spots will be open in the fall. Applying sooner helps you to secure higher seniority as well as secure your spot in the House.

Applicant Interview: Interviews will mostly take place in-person during applicant's weekend in the spring OR at another arranged time for your convenience over a video call. You will be contacted by the House management for an interview. The purpose of the interview is to help us get to know you better and to help you get to know us better! During the interview, we will share about the mission and purpose of the House and answer any questions you may have.

Official Acceptance: If you are accepted into the House, you will be notified and sent an official letter of acceptance, a House contract and a House commitment agreement. You will be asked to carefully read these documents. The House contract is a binding rental agreement. Once these are signed and returned to FBC, along with the \$300 security deposit, your spot will be official.

Welcome Packet & Move-In: In August we mail out an official packet detailing everything you need to know about moving in, house leadership, the house retreat and what to pack. New resident move-in day is typically on Saturday, one whole week before classes start.
